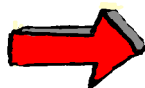

Sapiens: A Brief History of Humankind
by Hebrew University History Prof. Yuval Noah Harari

With no shortage of chutzpah, Hebrew University Professor of History has tackled the history of the human species in 400 pages and produced an international best seller. *Sapiens covers a vast sweep of 150,000 years and goes on from there to speculate on the future of our species. As such it is a book of big events and big ideas: the origins and impacts of agriculture, language, the industrial revolution, the information age, religion, ethics, and even happiness.*

Evolutionary anthropologist Avi Tuschman writing for the Washington Post states that whether or not one agrees with Harari's methods and conclusions, "[his] book is important reading for serious-minded, self-reflective sapiens."
