YOUTH & HIGH HOLIDAY OBSERVANCE

It can be disruptive as well as unsafe for youth to gather unsupervised outside of services or an organized program, so parents are requested to make sure your children are either with you in the main sanctuary, in the Children's Programming, or in childcare.

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMING

Children's Programming is for those in grades Kindergarten through 7th grade on Rosh Hashanah Day 1 and Yom Kippur morning. The program will be treated with similar importance to regular services. Children are expected to stay for the entire program and will not be released during services unless a parent comes to retrieve them.
